

# Potential 2010 All-star Candidates and their Parents

## ALL-STARS

Are teams of 12 to 14 players from each chartered Girls Softball League to compete with other leagues in an All-star Tournament. The team progresses in this tournament as follows:

1. District (17) this year will include Dutchess, Westchester, Rockland, & Orange Counties.
2. Sectionals — which are neighboring district winners.
3. New York State.
4. Regionals-12 state winners, and possibly higher

## QUALIFICATIONS

1. All girls are eligible to play in their assigned age division.
2. The eligible players must commit themselves to being available for **practices and games beginning as early as June 19th and continuing through the month of July.** (And possibly August, if the team is still involved in the tournament). Exceptions to this rule may be made on an individual basis for an important reason.

## SELECTIONS

1. Depending on the number of girls trying out in a division, tryouts may, or may not be required.
2. Selection to the team will be based on voting by the managers of that division along with the TOPGLLS President based on the tryouts (if needed), and regular season play. Managers will vote for 9 players.
3. The 9 players with the most votes are on the all star roster, the remaining roster is selected from the eligible candidates by the All-Star Manager, and the TOPGLL Softball President.
4. Try outs: Tryout dates and times are below, players **MUST** attend the tryouts to be considered. Permission slip and a copy of the player's birth certificate are required **at** tryouts — if not already given at registration. If a birth certificate is needed, the team manager will request a copy.
  - **9/10's – 06/15 – 6:30 pm @ Jackson Road (If needed)**
  - **11/12's – 06/16 – 6:30pm @ Jackson Road (If needed)**
  - **Juniors - 06/17 - 6:30pm @ Jackson Road (If needed)**
  - **Seniors - 06/18 - 6:30pm @ Jackson Road (If needed)**

District 17 plays a double elimination tournament which will begin approximately June 27th to July 13th. The girls may be scheduled to play any day of the week, possibly every day of the week. Any field in District 17 may be used-there are no "home" fields. You may need to travel.

The training is **extensive and intensive** in a short time. Mandatory **practices will usually be scheduled between 4 to 6 days a week beginning June 19th at one of our fields from 5:30 to 7:30pm** dependent on the availability of the manager and coaches.

There is an "all play" rule in the All-star Tournament. This means each player must **both** field for one inning (three outs), and bat one inning, it does **NOT** mean equal play. In all divisions, the Manager will assign positions to players as he/she feels appropriate to the game situation and advancing the team through the Tournament.

Please have yourself and your daughter sign and return this letter to indicate you and your daughter's understanding of the rules. Little League rules also require a photo copy of each athlete's Birth Certificate.
